

# A SUMMER WALK UP THE TYNE AND THE NORTH TYNE

Join artist Mike Collier and natural historians Keith Bowey, Matt Hawking, Steve Westerberg and Tina Wiffen walking from the mouth of Tyne, via Hexham up the North Tyne to Thorneyburn.

There are nine walks (graded easy to moderate) over five weekends in May and June 2011. Each walk should last between six and eight hours with regular stops to identify flora and fauna.

Sat 18 <sup>th</sup>	June	Bellingham	-	Thorneyburn	approx 7.0 miles
